

## 4 Days/3 Nights (EMR/HY)

Valid until 30 Sep 2009



### DAY 1: ARRIVE YAGON

Up on arrival, you will be welcome by Flight Travel Guide and transfer to hotel.

In the afternoon, your sight seeing begins with a visit to Kyaukhtatgyi Pagoda's 70m long reclining Buddha and the World Famous Shwedagon Pagoda which glittering with gold on the Singottara Hill, a breathtaking and colorful sight visited by Buddhists from all over Myanmar. Overnight in Yangon.

### DAY 2: YAGON

(B)

After breakfast, explore Yangon by car and partly on foot and take a close look at the lifestyle of local people in this historical city.

For an introduction, enjoy your day with the first stop at the National Museum, then to city center and stop for a while to take photos near the Sule pagoda. Walk around the Mahabandoola Park to see the colonial courthouse and the city hall.

From here we start a tour by car or by rickshaw around the colonial area with various historical buildings, breaking at a local teashop to enjoy Burmese tea and its traditional culture. The place is unique and the typical atmosphere. Continue along the famous Strand Road to the riverside near by Botahtaung Pagoda.

Visit Bogyoke Market formerly Scott's market offering a wide selection of Myanmar handicrafts and other goods (closed on Monday and public holidays). End the day with walking around in colorful Chinatown and visit one of Yangon's Chinese temples. Overnight in Yangon.

### DAY 3: YAGON - BAGO - YAGON

(B, L)

After breakfast at the hotel, leave Yangon and enjoy a scenic journey by road to Bago, 80km to the north west of Yangon. Bago is an ancient capital of a former Mon kingdom dating back to the 6th century. Sightseeing in Bago includes the beautiful 55-meter long reclining Buddha, Shwethalyaung, and the Mon style Shwemawdaw Pagoda, one of the most venerated in Myanmar. Its spire stands 114m high and is taller even than the Shwedagon Pagoda. Also visit the well-restored former palace Kambozathadi.

On the way back to Yangon, visit the Allied War Cemetery near Htaukkyan, the final resting place for over 27,000 allied soldiers. Overnight in Yangon.

### DAY 4 : DEPART YANGON

After breakfast, free at leisure with car and guide at disposal until your transfer to the airport for your departure flight.
